Reconstruction of Bridge 8-K-6 Grant Avenue Over Little Ease Run, Franklin Township

The County of Gloucester will be replacing Bridge 8-K-6 at Grant Avenue over Little Ease Run in Franklin Township.

PROJECT BACKGROUND: The County of Gloucester has contracted Walters Marine Construction, Inc. to complete a bridge replacement project along with associated roadway improvements for a total distance of 0.2 miles (+/-) at Grant Avenue over Little Ease Run in Franklin Township. The project is being constructed in order to address the deterioration and weight restriction of the current bridge. The bridge has deteriorated to such a condition that a complete replacement is necessary.

THE PROJECT: The project will consist of the removal and complete replacement of existing structure 8-K-6, and the resurfacing of the roadway on either side of the bridge structure. The full depth pavement construction will include installation of 6" of dense graded aggregate base course, 4" of HMA base course, and 2" of HMA surface course. The roadway resurfacing will include 2" of milling, along with the installation of 2" of HMA surface course. Guide rail will be installed on each side of the bridge and approaches. The proposed structure will consist of a prefabricated timber bridge on timber piles with a center pier.

This project is 100 % Federally funded.

Due to the nature of the construction activity, the bridge will be closed and a detour will be instituted. The detour will utilize Route 47, Coles Mill Road (CR 538), and Fries Mill Road (CR 655).

The detour is scheduled to start on or about Monday June 20, 2011 and is anticipated to remain in place for approximately 3 months. The roadway will remain open up to the bridge for local and emergency traffic only. There will be no traffic allowed across the bridge during the detour.

PROJECT STATUS: Demolition operations and will be the first to occur on the project. This project is anticipated being completed in 90 days.
